



### An update from Adrienne.....

To date, there has already been a 6% increase in referrals compared to 2017 statistics and October to February is always our busiest months! We could not operate this project without the continued support from the local community who donate items of food, toiletries and cash on a regular basis to support those affected by poverty. Donations were enhanced this month through harvest collections. Various schools and churches donated over 1 tonne of food which has increased our stock levels.

During the month of November, we plan to launch our Christmas appeals. We would like to beat the number of advent calendars we received last year. We donated 350 calendars as well as festive treats to most primary schools within Clackmannanshire and many children's

children's charities including Homestart, Community House, Women's Aid and local Family Centres. We also add festive treats to our food parcels throughout the Christmas period. We are now collecting advent calendars, selection boxes and festive items.

We will be operating a trolley drop in Tescos on Thurs 29 & Frid 30 Nov and Sat 1 Dec 2018. Volunteer assistance would be fully appreciated. If you have a spare hour or two, please let me know!

Our volunteers are the "backbone" to this project. Your assistance through shopping, sorting/dating stock, delivering parcels and engaging with service users is greatly appreciated.
